## SAMPLE RISK ASSESSMENT FOR SCHOOL VISIT - 90 MINUTES

Risk	Level	Action
Children near moving cars	Low	Car Park area separated from foot traffic and all children supervised by parents / teachers between car park and barn.
Allergic reaction to materials	Low	Materials list circulated to parents before visit; children with known allergy do not take part in bread making. Parents / teachers present to take appropriate action if child suffers an attack.
Burns from cooking activities	Low	Adults only handle oven and hot bread in a separate area of the barn.
Food contamination	Low	Materials stored appropriately and handled using food preparation gloves and aprons.
Road traffic	Low	Children confined within barn; entry and exit supervised by parents / teachers.
